WHY? Objectives of CBHE

- improve the quality of higher education and enhance its relevance for the labour market and society
- improve the level of competences and skills in HEIs by developing new and innovative education programmes
- enhance the management, governance and innovation capacities, as well as the internationalisation of HEIs
- increase the capacities of national authorities to modernise their higher education systems, by supporting to the definition, implementation and monitoring of reform policies
- foster regional integration and cooperation across different regions of the world through joint initiatives, sharing of good practices and cooperation

Consortium:

HEIs from 2 different Programme Countries HEIs from Partner Countries

≥ HEIs from Programme Countries

At least 2 HEI from each Partner Country

Structural projects: relevant authority of each targeted Partner Country And more: companies, businesses, NGOs, student associations

Joint Projects

Institutional level of HE

- Modernisation of curriculum (innovative courses and methodologies)
- Modernisation of governance, management and functioning of HEIs
- Strengthening of relations
 between HEIs and the wider
 economic and social environment

Structural Projects

Level of HE systems

- Modernisation of policies, governance, management and functioning of higher education systems
- Strengthening of relations between higher education and the wider economic and social environment

Relevant authority of each targeted Partner Country must be involved!

Duration and budget

- 2 or 3 years
- 500.000 1.000.000 EUR / project
- Staff costs (max. 40 %; unit costs)
 - Manager, researcher/teacher/trainer, technician, administrative staff
- Travel costs (unit costs)
- Costs of stay (unit costs) subsistence, accomodation, health insurance in involved countries
- Equipment (max. 30 %; real costs; for HEIs in Partner Countries only)
- Sub-contracting (max. 10 %; real costs) for competencies which cannot be covered by the consortium (financial audit, etc.)
