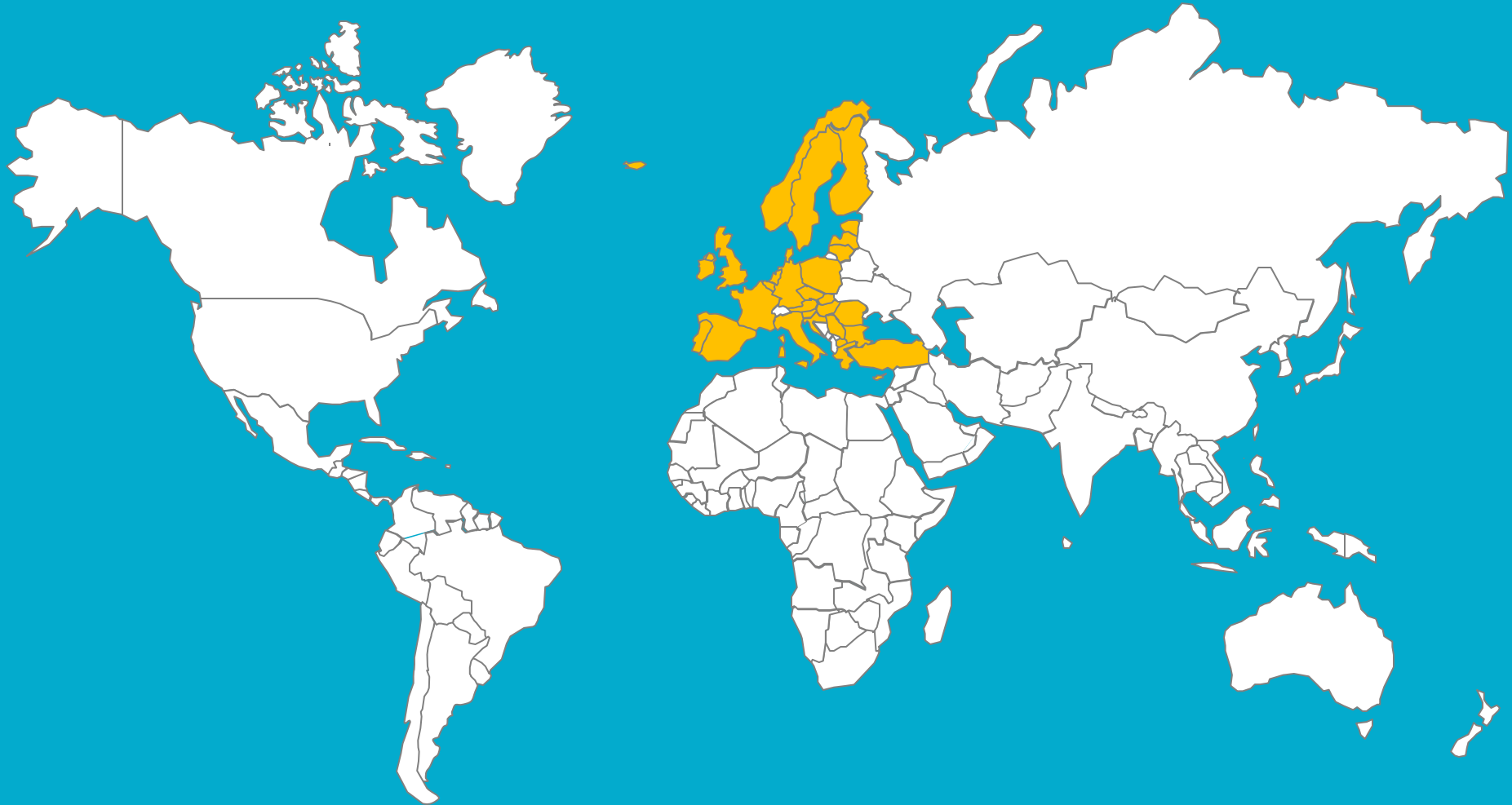

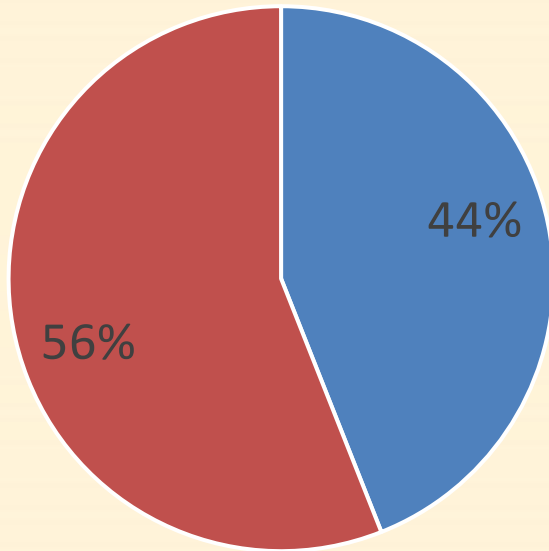
Estimated 2019 ICM Budget



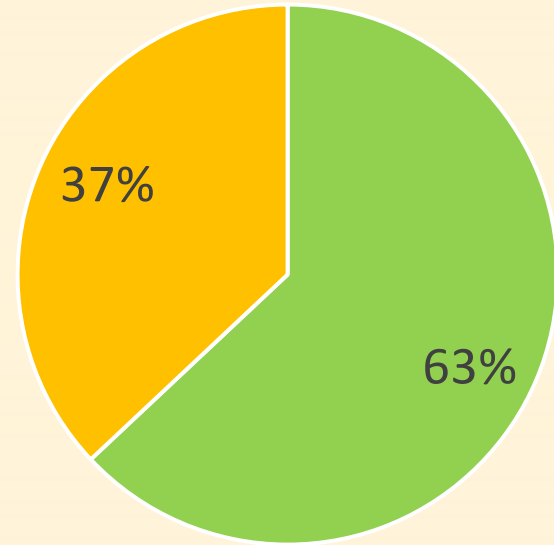

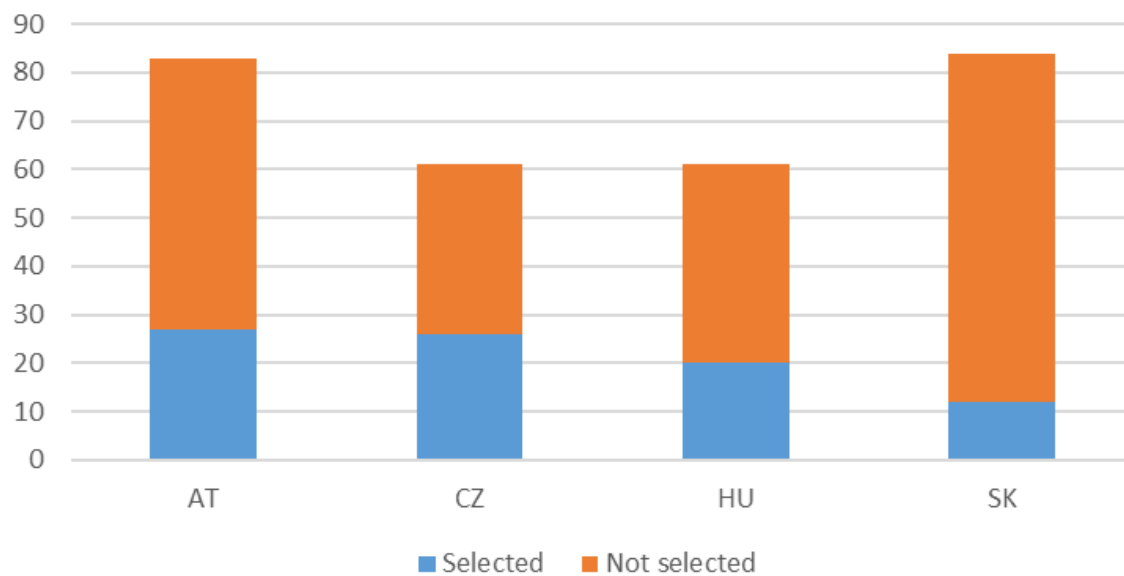

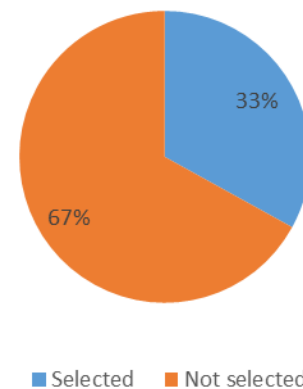

Total proportion of selected proposals

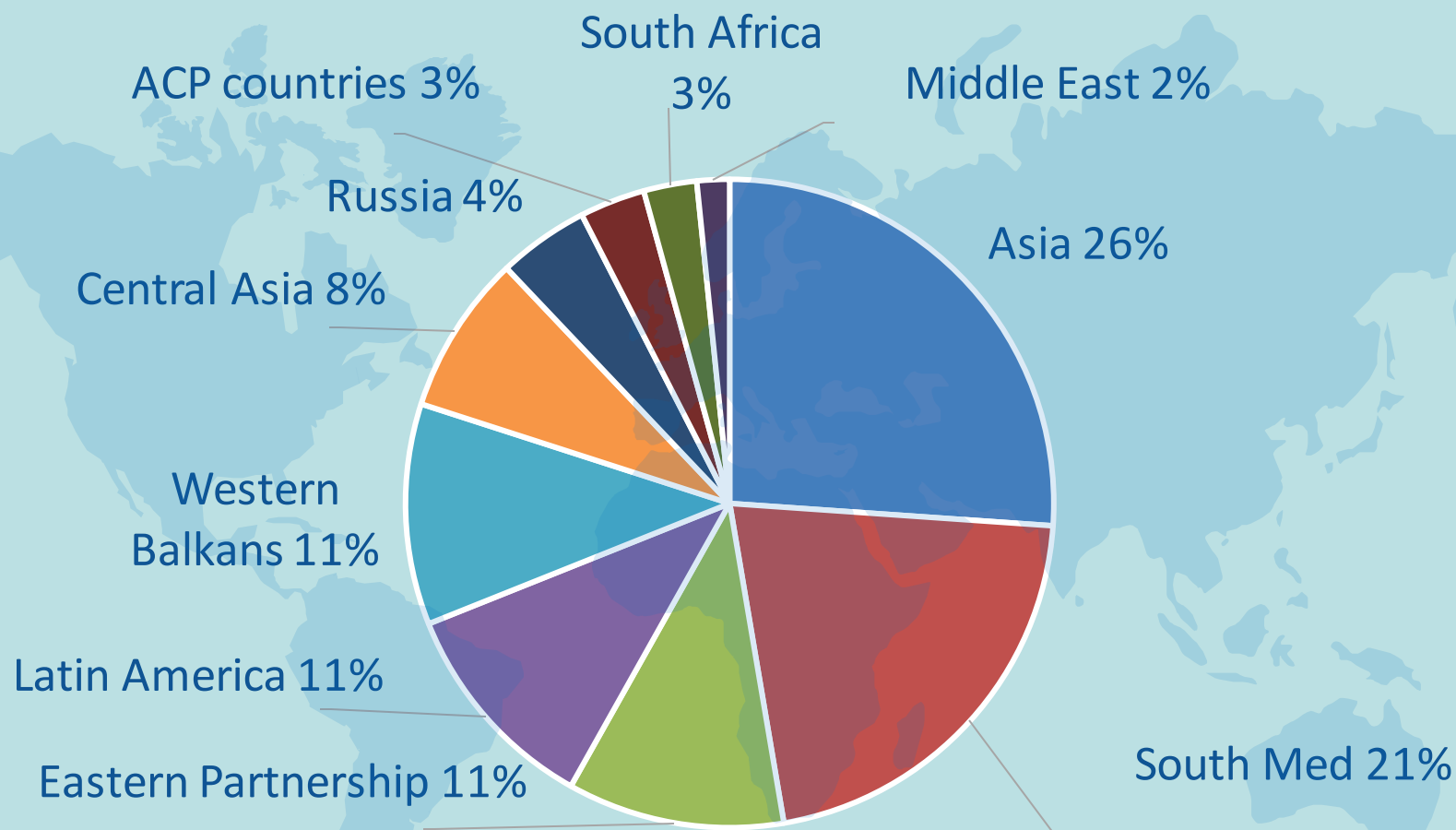

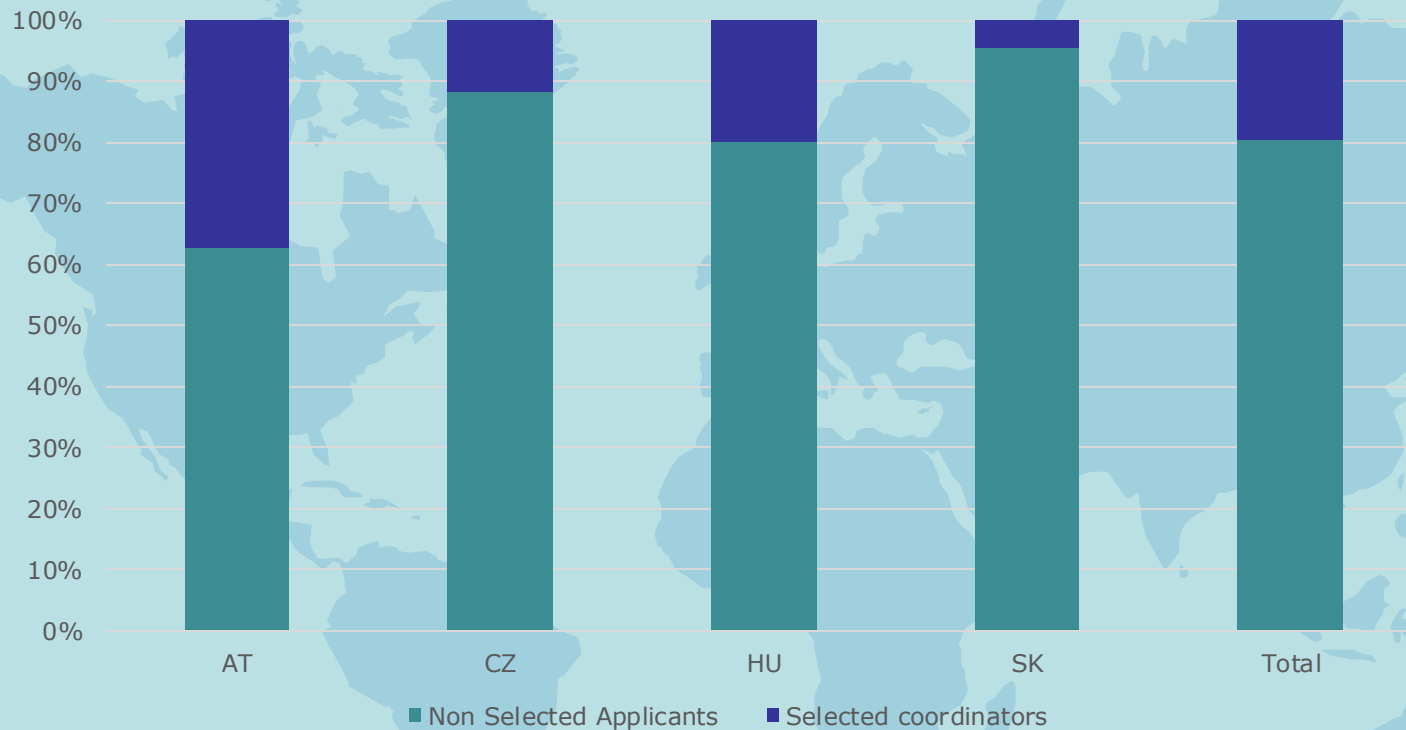
